This memorandum serves to highlight educational resources on Generative AI (Gen AI) available to the DAF military and civilian workforce. Dr. Craig Martell, former OSD Chief Digital and AI Officer, stated in his Oct 2023 memorandum, “to understand the risks posed by Gen AI models, it is essential to conceptually understand how these capabilities function.” To help Airmen and Guardians to understand Gen AI capabilities, risks, and ethical considerations, the DAF Chief Information Officer recommends the following courses through the MIT Horizon environment via Digital University at <https://digitalu.af.mil/>. (note: Once logged into a Digital University account, select the “Training Catalog” menu at the top of the page, then click the “Resources” link. Then follow the MIT Horizon “Go To Site” link.)
